

Marion County Burning Permits

Anyone needing to burn within an incorporated city should contact city authorities about any local burning ordinances. Many towns and cities have their own burning regulations that supersede the Division of Forestry's burning permit program.

Permits from the Division of Forestry are **free of charge** and may be obtained by calling the Division of Forestry phone number for the **county** where the burning will be done or by filling out the online application (choose option below). The number for the Department of Forestry for Marion County is 423 942 3665.

Permits will not be issued on days and in locations if it is considered unsafe to conduct a debris burn.
